



RESTRICTED MEMBERSHIP - CONDITIONS

As a Restricted Member

You ARE entitled to:

- Roll up or practise on the greens at any time when the greens (or a rink) are not otherwise in use, or booked to be used, for Tranmere Pennant matches, practices or other club events.

You are NOT entitled to:

- Vote at any meeting of members or hold office at the Club
- Enter or play in Tranmere Club Championship events
- Enter or play in any event for which registration with Bowls SA is a condition of entry unless you are registered with Bowls SA
- Play in any Tranmere Pennant team, except as a temporary player at the request of our selectors, providing you are not a registered bowler with another Club, or if you are, you have obtained a permit through Bowls SA to play at Tranmere

Term of Membership and Payment of Fees:

- To become a restricted member, you must apply for membership (using the membership application form and be proposed and seconded by a club member) and be accepted as such by the bowls section committee.
- Membership is confirmed on payment of the required membership fee
- A first time Restricted Member who joins in the first half of the year (ie from 1 September to 28 February) is required to pay the full annual fee for that year
- A first time Restricted Member who joins in the second half of the year (ie 1 March to 31 August) is required to pay half the full annual fee for the remainder of that year
- Membership may be renewed for the following year(s) by payment of the required annual fee.

Friday Morning Bowls

- A restricted member who plays Friday Morning Social Bowls will be entitled to pay the lesser daily fee applicable to members of the Tranmere Bowling Club.
