



What you need to know...

When are the games played?

Tranmere's winter bowls competition provides a sociable and fun afternoon enjoyed by all bowling participants. Games commence at 12 noon on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays. This enables an earlier finish on those cold winter afternoons and minimises getting caught up in peak hour traffic going home.

How do you get a game?

There is an entry form listed on the Club's Noticeboard each week for interested bowlers to list their team members for the respective day's game (either Wednesday Cosmo Triples and/or Friday or Saturday's Cosmo pairs). Individuals may also list themselves as a single entry at the bottom of the sheet. Coordinators will finalise team composition prior to the game's start of play.

It is important to note that entries for the games' play closes by 11.00am on the designated day.

Wednesday Cosmo Triples

Two games of 15 ends two bowl triples. First game only has a one end roll up.

Winners from the first game will play against other first game winners (winners pool), while the losers from the first game will play against other first game losers (losers pool) in their second game. The second game determines a winner and runner up from each pool.

As outcomes are based on the second game, prizes will be presented to the winning and runner up teams from each of the winners and losers pool.

Scoring

Winners of the second game are ranked according to the number of ends won in that game for each of the winners and losers pool.

Conditions

Ideally it is preferred that teams are of a mixed gender (both male and female), however, it is acknowledged that this is not always achievable.

It is strongly encouraged that only ONE bowler from Tranmere's first side plays in each team with the exception of Friday Cosmo pairs. This provides a balance of bowler skill level across the teams participating.

Casual dress.

Friday & Saturday Cosmo Pairs

First game of 11 ends; second game of 12 ends of 2-4-2 bowl format. First game only has one end roll up.

Winners from the first game will play against other first game winners (winners pool), while the losers from the first game will play against other first game losers (losers pool) in their second game. The second game

determines a winner and runner up from each pool.

As outcomes are based on the second game, prizes will be presented to the winning and runner up teams from each of the winners and losers pool.

Cost

Entry fee of \$8 per bowler includes tea/coffee/biscuits.
