- Mentor and develop a group of club-trained coaches to support long-term coaching and player development initiatives.

Key Responsibilities

The successful applicant will:

- Design and deliver inclusive coaching programs for players of all skill levels.
- Lead and coordinate structured training sessions.
- Provide guidance on the responsibilities and skills required for the positions of Lead, Second, Third, and Skip.
- Teach and demonstrate techniques, tactics, and game strategies appropriate to individual learning styles and development stages.
- Utilise effective communication and feedback methods to maximise player improvement.
